AM ENDE, Johann Heinrich

Pirna 1645 – Leipzig 1695

Portraitist and history painter, probably trained by his uncle Chr. Schiebling in Dresden. In 1682 he settled in Leipzig, where he executed a series of portrait miniatures (in oil on parchment) of 17 merchants from the city. Other portraits are known from engravings. A single pastel is cited in AKL, but the medium is described as oil in other sources.
