BOROVIKOVSKY, Vladimir Lukich

Mirgorod 4.VIII.1757 – St Petersburg 16.IV.1825
Владимир Лукич Боровиковский; pupil of Levitski and Lampi; member of the St Petersburg academy from 1795. Prolific Russian portraitist and painter of religious and allegorical works in the neoclassical style, influenced also by Vigée Le Brun and artists of the English school. A pastel version of one of his most important portraits has been attributed to him.
