BANKES, Anne

Dorset 23.IV.1759 – brd Wimborne 7.III.1778 Sister of Henry Bankes (1757-1834) of Kingston Lacy; apparently taught to use pastel by Harriet Woodley, later Mrs Pickard (q.v.). An oil portrait of Anne Bankes with her mother (née Margaret Wynne, daughter of the bishop of Bath & Wells) by Richard Roper (q.n) is in Kingston Lacy. There is possibly a confusion with her niece, Anne Frances Bankes (1790-1864) who, in 1810, married Edward Boscawen.
