BAYEU Y SUBIAS, Francisco

Zaragoza 9.III.1734 – Madrid 4.VIII.1795

The eldest of three brothers known for religious paintings, Francisco was also a prolific draughtsman. He was named painter to the king in 1764. Goya married his sister and painted his portrait. He worked for, and was influenced by Mengs. He became head of the Academia de San Fernando in 1788.
