## BEECHEY, Lady, née Anne Phyllis Jessup

Thorpe, Norwich 3.VIII.1764 – London 14.XII.1833

Second wife of Sir William Beechey ( $\infty$  1793); she left numerous pastels, drawings and miniatures. "Having very early discovered considerable talent in crayon drawing", Sir William's instruction was "gratuitous", according to Chambers (General history of the county of Norfolk, 1829). She exhibited five drawings at the Royal Academy in 1787. In 1795 she turned to miniatures, charging up to 10 gns each. She was a favourite of Queen Charlotte.
