## **BÉROUD, Pierre**

Suisse 1739 – p.1769

Pierre Béroud, a painter from Switzerland aged 30, living rue de la Lune, brought a law suit against one of his clients, Dujardy, receveur général des tabacs pour Nancy. He had made two pastels for him, the second of his wife, without being paid, and after several attempts to obtain payment, he entered Dujardy's home, rue d'Anjou, and removed the pastels. He was promptly accused of theft.
