BESANGÉ, Simon

The Hague bpt 8.v.1778–1801

Also Besanger. The son of the Simon Besangé (1742–1802) and Metje Camfferman (1745–1788), he became a member of Pictura in 1790, and received the small silver medal at the drawing school in The Hague in 1793. Listed as a painter; his man smoking a pipe was engraved by Nolthenius de Man.
