BIEDERMANN, Johann Jakob Winterthur 7.VIII.1763 – Aussersihl 10.IV.1830 Swiss topographical painter and engraver. The son of a baker, he was married four times, between 11785 and 1816. He was taught initially by Johann Rudolf Schellenberg. From 1778 he was in Bern and was influenced by Aberli (q.v.). His paintings, prints and watercolours are frequently found at acution, but only one pastel is known.
