BÖRNER, Gottlob

Dresden 1735–6.IV.1805

Dilettante; his exhibits won him some encouragement. He is likely to have been the Hofkommissar Börner whose interests included botany. He was Gottlob Börner, who died aged 69 according to the *Dresdner Anzeigen*, 15.IV.1805. He married a Johanne Sophie Gemlich. The B. Börner who appears in the 1803 livret, described as a pupil of Professor Schulze, is probably not the same figure, but perhaps a relative.
