## **BORELLY, Benoît, frère**

*fl.* Chartreuse de Villeneuve-les-Avignon XVIII<sup>e</sup>  
Also Borelli; Carthusian monk from the chartreuse de Villeneuve, where he studied with Frère Imbert (who numbered among his other pupils Subleyras, Duplessis, Parrocel and Duparc). Apparently he advanced pastel painting to perfection, particularly in two *marines*, “rares et précieux chefs-d’œuvres qui malheureusement ont disparu avec tant d’autres.” Masson (citing Ferdinand Servian) says he was active in Marseille.
