BÖTTNER, Wilhelm

Ziegenhain 24.II.1752 – Kassel 24.XI.1805
Painter of portraits and mythological pictures;
pupil of J. H. Tischbein in Kassel, before
travelling to Düsseldorf, Paris (1773), Rome
(1777), Vienna and Dresden. On his return to
Kassel in 1784 he was appointed Hofmaler. A
1787 group portrait of the family of Wilhelm
IX. von Hessen-Kassel is in the collection at
Schloß Fasanerie. The status of a couple of
pastels attributed to him is difficult to assess;
they seem below the accomplishment shown in
his oil portraits.
