Herr Brock, Maler in Kassel. had, after some research, discovered a substance to fix pastel to paper which would render the work impervious to rubbing or humidity. He appears to have been a pupil of Tischbein, and is recorded as a copyist of his portraits. Referred to as "der kleine Brock", it is unclear if he was the history painter active in Kassel for over twenty years specialising in ideal landscapes.
