Maastricht ?1682-1748 Also Broekhuizen etc. The polymathic captain of a company of the Guards (luitenant in 1715, luitenant-kolonel in 1730; he fought at Ramillies and Malplaquet) was also a poet, genealogist, scientist and miniature painter. In addition to his numerous manuscript writings on art and other matters, he founded, around 1700, a "Verhandeling over het maken en gebruyk der gecouleurde crionnen", of which no trace survives; nor do we know if he practised himself. It has been suggested that he may have been the author of the anonymous supplement on pastel painting printed with Boutet's Traité de la peinture en mignature in The Hague edition of 1708.
