BURCH, Edward

London bpt 30.X.1730–brd 16.II.1814

Gem-engraver and miniaturist. Studied at St Martin's Lane and the Duke of Richmond's academies, exhibiting at the Society of Arts from 1760. He became a Royal Academician in 1771, exhibiting prolifically between 1771 and 1808 (from Warwick Street, 1771–76; 24 Charlotte Street, thereafter). Only these two, undescribed, pastels are recorded.
