CLATERBOS, Augustijn

Haarlem 1750–1828

Also Augustus or Augustinus. A portrait painter, landscape artist, draughtsman and copyist; member of the Sint-Lucasgilde in Haarlem from 1777. He was also a wine tax collector (boekhouder en hoofdgaarder der belasting op wijnen). Only two pastels are known, one being the portrait of his first wife, whom he married in Haarlem in 1793; he remarried a year after her death.
