## CABANES DE PUYMISSON, Marc

Montpellier 15.II.1760 - Paris 2.XII.1831 Also Cabannes; Puimisson etc. The son of a négociant in Montpellier, on 5.V.1788 he was married in a Protestant ceremony to Marguerite-Pauline Martin, sister of Jacques-David Martin, baron de Campredon and a general. During the Revolution he enlisted as a sous-lieutenant in the 3e régiment d'infanterie and had a distinguished military career, becoming colonel of the 17e régiment in 1805, officier de la Légione d'honneur 1807, baron de l'Empire 1808. The only known work is the pastel selfportrait made aged 15, three years before the foundation of the Société des beaux-arts de Montpellier, which held a number of exhibitions in the town.
