CARNICERO y Mancio, Antonio

Salamanca 10.I.1748 – Madrid 21.VIII.1814
Painter, draughtsman, illustrator, theatrical decorator and etcher; son of a sculptor, he studied in Rome 1758–66 and Madrid. He turned to portraiture after Carlos III appointed him court painter in 1796 and drawing master to the Prince of Asturias. It is unclear if the two known pastels were made before 1800.
