CARRÉ, Hendrik II

The Hague 27.IX.1696–22.III.1775 Son of Hendrik I Carré (q.n.); Meyer suggests that that it was the son who worked in pastel, producing portraits (also in oil) and copies of Flemish paintings. A pupil of his father, he became a member of the Haagse Confreriekamer van Pictura in 1719. No pastels are known, but he practised most genres of fine and decorative art.
