CATEL, Franz Ludwig

Berlin 22.II.1778 – Rome 19.XII.1856 Painter and sculptor of religious and genre pictures as well as landscapes and portraits; possibly brother of architect Ludwig Friedrich Catel (1776–1819). Franz Ludwig studied in Berlin but was already in Switzerland at the time his only recorded pastel was shown in Berlin. Later he travelled in France and Italy, joining the Nazarene movement.
