

# Neil Jeffares, *Dictionary of pastellists before 1800*

## CAUSSÉ

*fl.* La Rochelle 1790

Worked as a portraitist in oil, pastel and miniature, and drew in three chalks landscapes, faces, flowers and maps; possibly to be identified with the draughtsman of the same name who exhibited in Toulouse in 1784 and 1790. A Pierre-Jacques Caussé (1765–1826) married, c.1790 in Toulouse, a Marie-Rose Imbert; his brother, François-Honoré Caussé (1776–p.1798), was described as an *artiste-musicien* at his marriage in Castres in 1798. Their parents were Jean-Jacques Caussé (c.1735–1786), from Albi, *maître de musique* du chapitre cathédrale de Saint-Pons, and Marie-Jeanne Catala.
