CHAUFOURIER, Jean

Paris 1675 – Saint-Germain-en-Laye 28.XI.1757
Chaufourier (also Chaufourrier or Chaufourien),
landscape painter, draughtsman and engraver;
adjoint à professeur pour la perspective. He also
made a few portraits. His father was an officier
du duc de La Rochefoucault, a brother-in-law
was a sellier de la Vennerie du roi at Versailles.
In 1703 he married a daughter of the engraver
Gérard Édelinck (when his profession was given
as graveur); after her death in 1724, he was
remarried, to a Jeanne-Renée Nalis or Nally, rue
Neuve-Saint-Augustin. When he witnessed the
marriage of his relative Grégoire-Antoine
Dupuis in 1730, he was described as
“dessinateur du roi.” He was *reçu* by the
Académie royale in 1735, under the patronage
of the duc d’Antin, whose death in 1736 was a
major setback to Chaufourier’s career. He
reestablished himself at Saint-Germain-en-Laye.
He taught Mariette (to whom he was related by
marriage, through the Édelinck and Dupuis
families), who nevertheless criticised his lack of
taste and his “manière...petite et
mesquine...qui ne tiroit point à l’effet.” He
exhibited two pastel landscapes at the Salon de
1748, “d’un très bon effet” according to the
Examen des principes ouvrages... Were these
accurately described? Mariette notes only that
“quelquefois il a colorié légèrement ses desseins
de veuës en se servant de couleurs à l’eau”. His
posthumous inventory listed a large number of
pictures, which may or may not have been by
Chaufourier himself – among them apparently
pendant pastel copies after Carriera and Raphael
which also appeared in his first wife’s inventory.
