## **CHIAPPE, Giovanni Battista**

Novi 1723–1765

Painter. After studying drawing with Giuseppe Paravagna in Rome, he worked in Milan and Genoa but died young. The pastels in the Palazzo Rosso formerly attributed to him are now thought to be by Sigismondo Betti (*q.v.*).
