CLAYPOOLE, James, Jr

Philadelphia 1743 – Kingston, Jamaica 22.III.1822

According to the Royal gazette of Jamaica, 8.VII.1780, James Claypoole, Limner, took over the art supply business of Mr Humfrays, and continued to paint portraits in oil, crayons and miniature, while also continuing his coachpainting and interior decoration. He was born in Philadelphia in 1743, the son of another James Claypoole, limner and portrait painter. On 8.v.1771, in Kingston, he married Helena Frazier.
