COMMODI, Andrea

Florence 1560–1638

Also Comodi. Portrait painter, frescoist and draughtsman, active in Rome and Florence. He was a pupil of Cigoli, and taught Pietro da Cortona. Among his studies are some sheets using pastel touches. Mariette, in mentioning these, says “il se faisoit gloire d’imiter le Baroche, dont il étoit autant partisan qu’il étoit de la manière de Corrège”, while Gabburri says “si diletò molto di dipingere a pastelli, seguendo in ciò il costume del Baroccio, del Cigoli e di Gregorio Pagani.” Monbeig Goguel cites a chalk autoritratto as an antecedent to Mola’s pastel.
