COYPEL, Noël

Paris 25.XII.1628–24.XII.1707

History, religious and portrait painter. He studied under Poussin and Le Sueur, completing the decoration of the Louvre from 1655. *Reçu* 1663, he became directeur of the Académie de France in Rome in 1672. He was the father of Antoine and grandfather of Charles and Noël-Nicolas Coypel (*qq.v.*).
