CROZAT, Mme Ambroise

fl. Toulouse 1761–65

Ambroise Crozat was a painter of religious subjects from Rodez, a pupil of Rivalz in Toulouse and briefly a rival of Subleyras. He is said to have painted portraits in Paris, but became addicted to alcohol and missed two appointments to paint Louis XV. His wife's details are not known.
