CZAPSKI, Antoni Michał, Graf Hutten-

3.IV.1725 – Warsaw 20.VII.1792
Son of Ignacy Czapski, the governor of Gdańsk; he became a lieutenant-general in the Polish army, and chamberlain of Chelm. He was also an amateur artist. He travelled to France and England, learning the art of miniature. He returned to Poland in 1749 to marry a daughter of Joseph Lipski. From 1771 he was in Gdańsk. Several portraits in miniature and pastel are said to be in the Czapski collection, now part of the Museum Narodowe w Krakowie.
