It has not been possible to identify the “Md. Damiani, de Venise” who is credited with ten pastels in the manner of Rosalba. She may have been a member of the Damiani family of whom several painters are known from later periods; or the name could be a misspelling of Damini. Le Brun is clearly correct to note that “les productions de cette Artiste nous sont très-peu connues”, although it is impossible to assess if they “méritent l’attention des amateurs”. The ten items in the single lot were offered in pairs.
