DEFRANCE, Léonard

Liège 5.XI.1735–22.II.1805

The son of Jean-Charles Defrance and Marie-Agnès Clermont, he was baptised at ND aux Fonts, Liège. On 16.IV.1765, at Liège, he married Marie-Jeann Joassin. Trained by Jean-Baptiste Coclers, the painter was active in Rome, Montpellier, Toulouse and the Netherlands before returning to Liège, where he founded the Académie des beaux-arts. No pastel is known.
