## **DELAPERCHE, Jean-Marie**

Orléans 1771 – Paris 1843

Pupil of David; he exhibited portraits at the Salons from 1824 to 1842. His work has been confused with that of his brother Constant (1790–), and perhaps also with that of Mme Laperche (*q.v.*), whom one suspects may be the author of the pastel of Linguet as it would seem odd that the pastel should have been signed “Mr Delaperche”.
