DERLANGE

fl. Bordeaux 1765

An advertisement in the *Annonces, affiches et avis divers ... de Bordeaux* (12.XII.1765) announced—

Le sieur *Derlange*, Peintre pour le Portrait, à l'huile & au Pastel, Place Dauphine chez *Ferrand*, Aubergiste, à l'Hôtel de Béarn, offre ses services au Public.

He may be the M. Derlange who advertised again, in the *Journal de Guienne*, 25.I.1786, offering candles as well as his services repairing porcelain etc. with glue. If so, he might be one of the sons of the Antoine Derlange (–1783), chandelier à Nancy, and his wife, Lucie Bailly (they were married at Nancy, Saint-Roch, 23.IX.1738), perhaps their son Jean Derlange, baptised in the same church, 29.VI.1745, or Jean-Nicolas, baptised at Saint-Nicholas, Nancy, 8.I.1752. Jean-Nicolas was later recorded as a medallist and engraver in Nancy (*Mémoires de la Société d'archéologie lorraine*, 1867, pp. 221–26).
