DEVIS, Arthur

Preston 19.II.1712 – Brighton 25.VII.1787 English portrait painter; pupil of Tillemans. His clientèle was mainly middle class and he specialised in conversation pieces and smallscale full-length figures. John Hayes suggested the attribution to Devis of the British Museum lady, but in the absence of other pastels by him, this must be entirely speculative.
