### DICKINSON, William

#### London ?1745 - Paris 19.VI.1823

Engraver. Of obscure origins, he may have been born in London, the son of Joseph and Grace, baptised at St Mary, Whitechapel, on 15.I.1745. He received a medal from the Society of Arts in London in 1767. Among the numerous portraits he reproduced were pastels by Lauer and Russell (qq.n). He was based in Paris from c.1802. A pastel sold in 1928 as by "W. Dickenson" is presumably (supposed to be) by the same artist, by whom no other example is known.
