DIETRICH, Christian Wilhelm Ernst

Weimar 30.X.1712 – Dresden 23.IV.1774

The prolific artist Dietrich, or Dietricy, worked in a number of genres in Weimar, Dresden, St Petersburg, Vienna etc. Brieger reproduces a couple of chalk drawings which are not conventional pastels. The attribution of neither the pastel in Warsaw nor that sold in 2005 seems secure, and there is no other evidence that he worked in the medium.
