DIJK, Johannes van

The Hague .iii.1718–6.x.1798

Son of Hendrik van Dijk and Louise Blotelingh; married Anna Maria van Kervel in Scheveningen in 1747, and Anna Adrian Verschuring in 1784. He was a theological student in Leiden; preacher in Name 1749, Maastricht 1757; professor at the Illustre School te Maastricht from 1765. He was also an amateur artist of portraits and landscapes. There are portraits of him by Bolomey and Sompsois (*q.v.*), showing him in clerical dress. There are several portraits of children of the Cazaux family, made between in 1780 and 1782, in Amersfoort.
