## DINGLINGER, Sophie Friederike

Dresden 1736–1791

Miniature painter and pastellist; the daughter of a goldsmith, Johann Friedrich Dinglinger, and pupil of Oeser. She invented a method of fixing pastel which was adopted by Dora Stock (q.r.) among others. It seems to have permitted deeper colours and an exceptionally naturalistic treatment of fabrics of different kinds.
