### DRUIJNEN, Cornelis van

Cuijk bpt 22.II.1761–brd 20.IV.1806

A series of pastels signed C. van Druynen are recorded in the rKD files, almost all dated 1788; an oil painting of 1789 is also recorded. It seems likely that this is the same artist as the “Cl. van Drunen” who made pastel copies after portraits by Le Gru. He is here (2024) identified as the “Cornelis van Druijnen, Kunstchilder”, party to a deed (pandveiligheid, or mortgage) of a house in Koningstraat for 800 guiders, dated 2.II.1797 (Stadsgerichten Nijmegen, inv. 2004, f° 9). A similar document the following year, 1.IV.1793 for a house in Vleeshouwerstraat names his wife as Wilhelmina Hermina de Swart. They were married in Rotterdam, 8.XII.1791, when the artist was living in Riviervismarkt, but born in Cuijk, a municipality near Nijmegen. Van Druijnen died there in 1806, and his widow married, on 1.II.1807, Jan Anthonij van der Poll.
