## **DUMACK, Carl Wilhelm**

Berlin 1766–7.III.1813

C. W. Dumack was a student in the Berlin Akademie in 1791. He was no doubt the Carl Wilhelm Dumack, Bürger of Berlin and Servis-Verordneter, whose death on 7.III.1813 in his 47<sup>th</sup> year was announced by his widow, née Caroline Henriette Bulß, and his parents, Christoph Bartholomäus and Anna Catharina Dumack. There is a brief reference to him in a contemporary journal: on 26.VII.1788, he was a member of a party that watched a particularly fine sunset in the Harz mountains. Perhaps this inspired the 1791 exhibit.
