FANCELLI, Pietro

Bologna 18.v.1764 – Pesaro 22.I.1850 Art restorer and painter, draughtsman and theatrical designer. Taught by his father in Venice, he returned to Bologna to enroll in the Accademia Clementina (which was to become the Accademia nazionale di belli arte in 1804). The pastel in the Accademia's collection is of the landscape painter with whom Fancelli often collaborated.
