FARSETTI, Daniele

Venice 23.VIII.1725–12.III.1787

Cousin of the celebrated collector Filippo Farsetti (1704–1774), Daniele was an amateur whose accomplishments included literature, pastel painting and the violin. Some of his pastels (amateur copies after other works) were sent to the Campo S. Rocco exhibition by the painter Giuseppe Angeli, who reports their success with “sycophantic enthusiasm”.
