FAURÉ, Mlle, la cadette

f. Toulouse 1767–70

Mlle Fauré or Faure cadette, pupil of the Académie; possibly related to Jean-François Fauré (*q.v.*). She exhibited numerous exercises in drawing, pastel and unspecified media no doubt reflecting the pieces assigned to her for copying, which included religious works, flower pieces and an unspecified portrait by Perronneau.
