**FAYE, Mme P.-A. de Villoutreys
de, née Julie-Jeanne-Nicole
Marcassus de Puymaurin**

Toulouse c.1750 – Faye, Flavignac 14.II.1805

The amateur exhibitor Mme de Faye can be identified as Julie Marcassus de Puymaurin, daughter of Nicolas-Joseph Marcassus, baron de Puymaurin (1718–1791), art collector and patron of Rivalz, Despax etc. In 1771 she married Pierre-Louis-Auguste de Villoutreys de Faye (1730–1802), chevalier de Saint-Louis, lieutenant-colonel de cavalerie, brother of the vicaire-général de Toulouse. They had five children. Her date of death is given incorrectly in most sources but is here corrected from the town records.
