FERRETTI, Giovanni Domenico

Florence 1692–1768

History, religious and mythological painter; also worked in fresco. He taught Violante Ferroni (*q.v.*). It is likely that the two pastels in Gabburri's inventory were those lent to the Florence exhibition in 1724; a number of other drawings and pictures in undescribed media were shown that year and in 1737, one belonging to Violante Beatrix.
