Florence 15.VI.1692–18.VIII.1768 History, religious and mythological painter; also worked in fresco. He taught Violante Ferroni (q.n). It is likely that the two pastels in Gabburri's inventory were those lent to the Florence exhibition in 1724; a number of other drawings and pictures in undescribed media were shown that year and in 1737, one belonging to Violante Beatrix.
