FLEMMING, Johann Heinrich **Joseph Georg Graf von**

Dresden 9.III.1752 – Schloß Croßen 7.VI.1830
The son of Carl Georg Friedrich Graf Flemming (1705–1767) and his wife, Henriette, Prinzessin Lubomirska (1720–1782), Johann Heinrich Joseph Georg was born in Dresden where his father was a minister. His uncle Graf Jerzy Detloff Fleming [Georg Detlev von Flemming] (1699–1771) married successively two Czarторыska sisters. Johann Heinrich matriculated at the university of Leipzig in 1767 but went the following year to Wittenberg, from where he sent his amateur submission to the Dresden exhibition in 1769. He was later Krongrößschwertträger von Polen. In 1782 he married Christiane Marie Charlotte Gräfin von Hardenberg.
