### FRAGONARD, Mme Jean-Honoré, née Marie-Anne Gérard

Grasse 22.XII.1745 – Le Pré-Saint-Gervais

25.V.1823

Marie-Anne, or Anne-Marie, Gérard was born in Grasse, the daughter of a perfumer and sister of Marguerite Gérard (q.v.) On 17.VI.1769 at Paris, Saint-Lambert-de-Vaugirard, she married Jean-Honoré Fragonard (q.v.). She was a miniaturist, exhibiting in the Salon de la Correspondance in 1779. Recent research has attributed to her a group of miniatures executed in a distinctive vaporous style which have previously been attributed to Fragonard himself. The Vassal de Saint-Hubert pastel must belong to the same hand. Auction records for undescribed drawings may have been in pastel.
