Dresden 4.III.1749–20.I.1815

Daughter and pupil of the painter David Friedrich; she became a well-known still-life and flower painter in oil and gouache, and a member of the Dresden Akademie. Only one pastel is recorded, from the early nineteenth century. Her friend Schenau (*q.v.*) portrayed her in pastel.
