### FRONTIER, Jean-Charles

#### Paris 22.VIII.1701 – Lyon 2.IX.1763

Pupil of Claude-Guy Hallé, he specialised in religious subjects. Prize-winner in 1728 at the Académie royale; *reçu* in 1744. In 1748 he was witness at the marriage of Chardin's sister Marie-Claude, to Jean-Baptiste-Paul Mopinot. He moved to Lyon soon after, where his pupils included Jean-Jacques de Boissieu. His burial certificate at Lyon, Saint-Pierre-Saint-Saturnin, signed by Nonnotte and others, was indeed dated 1763 (not 1753, as Jal "corrected"). The only pastel recorded, in the 1773 sale, was "Une composition, une étude pour un Apollon, & une tête au pastel, par *Frontier.*"
