FUCHS, Georg Mathias

Regensburg 9.x.1719 – Copenhagen 5.iv.1797
Pupil of Amigoni in Venice before moving to Copenhagen c.1753; landscape, decorative and genre painter as well as portraitist. In 1756 he married Birgitte Louise Berg (1733–1802), no doubt the vendor of a pastel by him. He etched a version of Boucher's celebrated pastel *Tête de Flore*.
