GAUTIER-DAGOTY, Arnauld-Éloi, dit Édouard

Paris 30.VI.1744 – Florence 8.V.1783

Third son of Jacques-Fabien Gautier-Dagoty (*q.v.*), in .X.1765 he enrolled in the école de l'Académie royale under Boucher, living with “son pere Graveur en couleur”. He made a small number of prints, on one of which he is described as a member of the Académie de Toulouse. He was married twice. In 1782 he emigrated to Italy with his second wife, Marie Rousselain, but died soon after.
